CHARITY SPOTLIGHT

This month our Charity Spotlight shines on Safe Passage, a program designed to steer children away from participating in troublesome behavior and possible gang affiliation. Safe Passage is an outreach program for vulnerable youth from kindergarten through sixth grade. Safe Passage Centers are open six days a week, free of charge to hundreds of underserved youth, who live within micro-communities that have traditionally been targets for gang recruitment and violence. Safe Passage focuses on "Steamo," Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Medicine, Outdoors. Its activity components include:

Art, Music, Culture, Community Literacy, Academics Mentorship, Resiliency, Curiosity, Grit

Safe Passage uses many of the gang's proven recruitment pillars to fill the void for youth. Gangs provide a sense of belonging, safety, infrastructure and education. At Safe Passage, they say "Stop the supply chain of future gang members and in turn, make tomorrow's business and community leaders.




